

Phase V Training (2009) of the Mid Career Training (MCT) Programme for IAS officers

The four-week Phase V Training (2009) of the Mid Career Training (MCT) Programme for IAS officers is mandatory in nature and is scheduled to be conducted during 5th January – 30th January, 2009 at IIM Ahmedabad. The programme is to be jointly conducted by IIM Ahmedabad and Harvard Kennedy School (HKS), USA.

The IAS officers of **1981 and 1982 batches** are eligible to attend the January 2009 programme. For the IAS officers of 1981 batch, the January 2009 programme is the terminal chance to participate in and complete the Phase V training, and, therefore, it is imperative that all of them have to enrol for and participate in the January 2009 programme. The officers of 1982 batch are also invited to participate in the programme. Therefore, the IAS officers of 1981 and 1982 batches are requested to kindly enrol “on-line” for the Phase V Training (2009) on or before 24th November, 2008.

Some of the IAS officers of **1979 and 1980 batches** (list placed below), who could not attend the earlier Phase V training, have been given a final opportunity to participate in the Phase V Training (2009) of the MCT, and, therefore, they are requested to kindly enrol for the programme “on-line” on or before 24th November, 2008.

The Controlling Authorities (Chief Secretaries of States/UTs and Secretaries of Government of India) have been addressed in this connection by the Joint Secretary (Training), DoP&T, and the copies of such letters are placed below for the kind information of the officers.

Please refer to the D.O letter No.12017/26/2004-TNP (S) dtd. 26/10/07 from the former Secretary (P) regarding the Phase-V training of the mandatory Mid-Career Training (MCT) Programme for IAS officers. The 1st and 2nd rounds of the mandatory MCT Programme have been successfully completed and the 3rd round of the mandatory MCT Programme is to start in 2009 with the Phase-V scheduled during 5th - 30th January 2009, Phase-IV during April-June '09 and the Phase-III during June-August '09.

2. This letter deals with the steps that are required to be taken for the smooth conduct of the 3rd round of the Phase- V training, scheduled to be conducted during 5th - 30th January 2009 at IIM Ahmedabad. The 4-week Phase-V training of the mandatory MCT Programme for IAS officers is mandatory in nature and can be undergone by the IAS officers between 26th and 28th year of their service. Completion of the Phase-V training is the minimum requirement for drawing further increments after the 28th year of service. The Phase-V training will be conducted jointly by the IIM Ahmedabad and the Harvard Kennedy School (HKS), Harvard University, USA.

3. The feedback received from the participants in the earlier Phase-V training has been considered in detail and appropriate changes have been made in the design and curriculum of the programme. Accordingly, the 4-week programme would now be organized with the opening week earmarked for the 'Core' subjects followed by 'Elective' modules during the 2nd and 3rd weeks, and culminating into an integrative 4th week with 'Core' inputs. Efforts are on to have a wider choice and flexibility in the composition of the 'Electives' to suit the diverse professional needs of the officers.

4. Officers of the 1981 and 1982 batches are eligible to participate in the Phase-V training in January 2009. The year 2009 would be the terminal year of eligibility for the officers of the 1981 batch to undergo the Phase-V training, and, therefore, it is imperative that all the IAS officers of the 1981 batch are nominated for the Phase-V training (2009).

5. Consequently, you are requested to kindly direct the IAS officers of the 1981 and 1982 batches to enrol 'online' for the Phase-V training. **The last date for 'online enrolment' is 24th November 2008.** We have made provision for the 'online enrolment' of the officers and the procedure for the same is explained in the enclosed **Annexure**. After the completion of the enrolment process of the officers of both 1981 and 1982 batches, we will communicate as to which of the officers of the 1982 batch need to be released for participation in the Phase-V (2009) programme.

6. On completion of the 'online enrolment' by the officers, the institutions conducting the programme will communicate with the officers individually to convey further details of the programme like course curriculum, reading materials etc.

7. Finally, since the Phase-V training will commence on 5th January 2009, and having regard to the mandatory nature of the training programme, I request you to kindly release (i) all the IAS officers of 1981 batch and (ii) the officers of 1982 batch, whose names will be communicated to you separately by us, so as to enable them to reach IIM Ahmedabad by the evening of 4th January 2009 for participation in the Phase-V training programme.

This letter deals with the participation of the IAS officers of 1979 and 1980 batches in the Phase-V training (2009) of the mandatory MCT Programme.

2. The IAS officers of 1979 and 1980 batches were provided opportunities to participate in the Phase-V training of the mandatory MCT programme conducted in the years 2007 and 2008. However, some of the officers from both the batches didn't avail the opportunity. 3.
